International Tickets

This year sees a major change in the way that Tickets for international matches may be purchased, as a number of options may **ONLY** be purchased online.

If you wish to buy these tickets, please use the click through button on the CRFC website home page. The link from this button recognises that the tickets are being purchased through CRFC and the club will gain commission on these sales. They are no more expensive than going direct to the SRU website, and the money generated is very important to the club.

Vacancies

International Ticket Policy:

1. All members are entitled to apply for International tickets. Any applications for tickets received after 31 August 2011 will only be considered if there are surplus tickets available after all orders received prior to that date have been satisfied in full.
2. As a result of the SRU's allocation policy and in keeping with Club Policy outlined in last season's Ticket Application Form, Club Members who bought tickets for Six- Nations matches at Murrayfield during the 2010 - 2011 Season will be given priority in the Allocation of tickets for the Murrayfield games in Season 2011 - 2012. It is assumed this policy will continue from Season to Season for the foreseeable future. **Please Note:** It's emphasised that this policy relates to **HOME** games only. **Ticket allocations for Twickenham, Millennium Stadium, Lansdowne Road, Stade de France and Stadio Flaminio are NOT affected by this policy.**
3. Once the Club's ticket allocation has been distributed in compliance with Item 2, the remainder of Home tickets, and all Away tickets, will be distributed on the basis of one ticket per member until all grades of membership have been satisfied. If there's a shortage in meeting total demand, the following priorities will be applied to Ticket Distribution: Committee, Hon. Life Member, Life Member, Ordinary Member, Associate Member and then others of Associate Status. Only after all grades of Member are allocated one ticket, will a second round of Ticket allocations be made by the same method and so on until such time as the Club's ticket supply has been fully allocated.
4. For away matches, preference will be given within the above priorities to members who can assure the Committee they are personally travelling to matches, e.g. have booked through Club-sponsored Tours.
